Brief information items for practices

Only musculoskeletal podiatry to the MSK MATT, all other podiatry to the community podiatry service

Some referrers have misunderstood the communications about podiatry referrals – please note that the MSK MATT service only assesses and treats biomechanical issues affecting the feet such as painful musculoskeletal conditions. The MSK MATT has NOT taken over as the provider for all podiatry cases. The MSK MATT pro forma has been revised with additional wording “Do NOT use this form if the patient needs Nail Surgery, or has diabetes / ischaemia / immunocompromised / neuropathy / ulcers / infection (use the dedicated Podiatry Forms instead)”.

The two Podiatry forms (one for patients with diabetes, one for patients who do not have diabetes) contain important decision support information to help you prioritise urgency, as well as explicit instructions on which clinics to refer the patient to via the eReferral Service (eRS). In general, it is recommended to use the Podiatry referral forms when considering a referral for foot problems.
