Mental health services for veterans

NHS England has launched the NHS Veterans' Mental Health Complex Treatment Service, a community based service for ex-forces personnel who have military attributable complex mental health problems that have not improved following previous treatment.

Patients using the service will benefit from an enhanced range of intensive care and treatment that may include (but is not limited to) support for substance misuse, physical health, employment, accommodation, relationships and finances, as well as occupational and trauma focused therapies.
