Title: Townlands Stakeholder Reference Group – Outpatient Clinic Update

Date: 4 October 2016

Purpose: To update the Townlands Stakeholder Reference Group on the development

and expansion of outpatient clinics at the new Townlands Hospital

Key Points: There are eight clinic rooms available in the new hospital and much work

has been undertaken to increase the number of clinics held at Townlands

Hospital.

Within the old hospital, four clinic rooms were available with an average of 700 attendances per month. Since moving to the new hospital this has

increased to over 1000 attendances per month.

The increase in activity is a combination of both increasing existing services

and new clinics starting (see Appendix 1).

A minor procedures room is also available which has enabled a 'see and treat' dermatology service to be commenced, whereby patients requiring a minor operation can have this carried out on the same day as their

outpatient appointment.

Services are accessible via Choose and Book and the indicative waiting

times are outlined in Appendix 2.

Market share and demand analysis is undertaken to ensure there is a need

for services prior to any changes in clinician job plans being made.

Potential new services that are being scoped in terms of market share and

man power availability include diabetes and respiratory.

Feedback from both patients and clinical teams continues to be extremely

positive.

RBFT held an open evening for GPs on 27 September 2016 to discuss the outpatient services, future plans and gain first hand referrer feedback. This

was a very positive evening for all.
