

Inputting Learning Disability Annual Health Check Data

After you have completed a Learning Disability Annual Health check, please ensure you follow these guidelines when entering in the information into EMIS/CQRS.

Important notice:

 Only Annual Health Checks that have been coded accurately will be pulled through to CQRS. Your practice will only get paid for those Annual Health Checks that are pulled through.

Learning Disability Register:

- Patients with a learning disability MUST be coded as **On the learning disability register**-> snomed code **416075005** (**918e READ Code**).
- If you would like to have your learning disability register checked, please contact the primary care liaison nurse covering your practice.

Entering data into EMIS:

- Please make sure that you use the following codes when reporting an Annual Health Check on EMIS:
 - → 442127005 (READ code: 69DB) code for: Learning disabilities health examination.
 - → 199751000000100 (READ code: 9HB5) code for: Learning disabilities annual health assessment.
 - → 712491005 (READ code: 9HB4) code for: Learning disabilities annual health action plan completed.
 - → 413163007 (READ code: 9HB2) code for: Learning disabilities health action plan reviewed.
 - → 514021000000103 (READ code: 9HB6) code for: Learning disabilities annual health assessment declined.
 - → 413162002 (READ code: 9HB0) code for: Learning disabilities health action plan declined.
 - → DO NOT USE CODE 413126003 (READ code: 9HB3) (this is for a learning disability health assessment. THIS IS THE WRONG CODE AND YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE PAYMENT FOR COMPLETING THE ANNUAL HEALTH CHECK IF YOU USE THIS CODE.
- When using a template for the Annual Health Check:
 - → Please make sure that 199751000000100 or 442127005 (correct codes for an Annual Health Check assessment) is attached to the template correctly.

CQRS:

- You NEED to have declared your Annual Health Checks through CQRS in order to get paid.

- → This is done using the 'achievement' page.
- → When you need to input your data, this will be flagged/ a system message will appear on the homepage.
- When declaring your Annual Health Checks, the "submitted value" will be the figure reflecting the number of CODED annual health checks.
 - → It is important that you code your Annual Health Checks correctly (code = 19975100000100/442127005), as only those coded will be pulled through to CQRS.
- The number of patients on the learning disability register at your practice/surgery must be **manually** inputted into CQRS (using values from EMIS).
- When entering your register size into CQRS, you must enter your register size EVERY QUARTER!!
 - → If you don't enter the register size every quarter, the register size will reset to 0...
 - → ...this will lead to inaccurate QOF data!
