## **Thames Valley Priorities Committee Commissioning Policy Statement**

Policy No. 182d (TVPC6) Arthroscopic lavage and debridement for patients with

osteoarthritis of the knee

Recommendation by TVPC May 2014/ Updated July 2018<sup>1</sup>; May 2021<sup>2</sup>

Date of issue September 2021

The Thames Valley Priorities Committee has considered the evidence for treatment of osteoarthritis of the knee as per the <a href="NICE Clinical Guideline 177">NICE Clinical Guideline 177</a> Osteoarthritis: Care and management in adults and recommends that arthroscopic lavage and debridement for patients with osteoarthritis of the knee is **NOT NORMALLY FUNDED**.

Do not refer for arthroscopic lavage and debridement as part of treatment for osteoarthritis of the knee, unless the person has knee osteoarthritis with a clear history of mechanical locking (as opposed to morning joint stiffness, 'giving way' or X-ray evidence of loose bodies).

#### NOTES:

- Potentially exceptional circumstances may be considered by a patient's CCG where there is evidence of significant health status impairment (e.g. inability to perform activities of daily living) and there is evidence that the intervention sought would improve the individual's health status.
- This policy will be reviewed in the light of new evidence or new national guidance, eg, from NICE.

W82.2 Endoscopic resection of semilunar cartilage NEC

Note: Where both irrigation and removal of loose bodies are performed during the same procedure, then it is only necessary to record W85.1 Endoscopic removal of loose body from knee joint
