3. Winter 2018/19 professional indemnity funding for OOH GPs

NHS England will cover the cost of professional indemnity for any additional extended or out-of-hours work undertaken by GPs this winter to give GPs freedom to work additional sessions without having to pay additional subscriptions to their medical defence organisation (MDO).
