Dear All

This is a reminder that there is now a GP-led dermatology service running from Woodlands Surgery in Didcot, for surgical removal of low-risk Basal Cell Carcinomas (low-risk being below the clavicle, and less than 1cm). We also treat solar keratoses and Bowen's (if topical treatment has failed or is not appropriate). We are two local GPs, Adam Jones and Estelle James, who have done training at the dermatology department at the Churchill, and we are accredited for removal of these lesions. Our service went live in February 2017 and is running well. Patients like being seen closer to home, and we don't have long waits for appointments.
