

## **Actions from the OX12 Listening Event**

- 1. Following a suggestion by Nick Duffin, members of the OX12 Stakeholder Reference Group agreed to put together a set of suggestions on what could be done differently when the population health management approach is rolled out to other localities.**

- 2. It was agreed that the CCG will organise a reflection event with stakeholders at the end of the project to capture additional learning and to inform the project evaluation.**

- 3. Jo Cogswell will ensure that dates are set in advance for future Stakeholder Reference Group meetings.**

Dates agreed in advance, albeit changed due to pre-election restrictions

- 4. A formal update on the current status of legionella in Wantage Hospital.**

OHFT advise that the water installation is being continuously treated with hydrogen peroxide to limit the opportunity for bacterial growth. The system is also being tested for legionella on a weekly basis. It should be noted that parts of the system are isolated (ie. no water is passing through them). Latest results show no legionella bacteria present (within measurable parameters).

- 5. The cost of maintenance of the part of the building that is currently closed.**

It can be approximated that the currently unutilised areas of the building are incurring a maintenance cost of about £54,750.

Given the age and condition of the water installations OHFT have just tendered for the replacement of the water incomers and main spine systems.

- 6. The CCG encourages the Practices to share all relevant developments regarding the proposed expansion with the PPG.**
