

OCCG Area Prescribing Committee (APCO) Bullet Points – Meetings 10th July 2018 and 11th September 2018

A summary of the decisions taken at the July and September APCO meetings and ratified by the OCCG Clinical Ratification Group (CRG) can be found on the OCCG ClinOX here: https://clinox.info/clinical-support/Medicines/medicines-management/area-prescribing-committee-oxfordshire.htm

APCO meet every two months where decisions are made about changes to the OCCG formulary and prescribing 'traffic lights' (available here: http://www.oxfordshireformulary.nhs.uk/) and agreement of shared care protocols and prescribing guidelines.

Key items from these meeting include:

- Shared Care Protocols Updated SCPs for Ivabradine (Angina and Heart Failure), hydroxycarbamide (myeloproliferative disorders and Essential Thrombocythaemia) and a new SCP for oral antibiotics for the management of Bone and Joint Infections
- Formulary decisions made/updated Invicorp (aviptadil with phentolamine) for erectile dysfunction, Ciprofloxacin ear drops (Cetraxal®) 2mg/ml,
 Trimovate cream, Actipatch electromagnetic pulse therapy patches, Etoricoxib for pain relief in patients with an inherited bleeding disorder, Donepezil, galantamine, rivastigmine and memantine for the treatment of Alzheimer's disease
- Guidelines agreed/updated Botulinum Toxin A policy update, Guidance for opioid reduction in primary care, Advice for GPs on managing Insomnia, Barrier Cream pathway, South Central Antimicrobial Network – Guidelines for Antibiotic Prescribing in the Community, Migraine – acute treatment and prophylaxis, Migraine in pregnancy, DVT documents update: D-dimer testing in DVT diagnosis
