

Cancer appointments – information for patients

Please would all surgeries remind their clinicians and admin staff that if a patient is sent for a 2ww appointment they need to be given:

- The TWEEK leaflet (this is a mandatory box for GPs on the referral form). If you forget to hand it out at the time of referral, send it via a link on AccuRx, email, text, or snail mail but PLEASE give it out.
- Advice that the first appointment must be made within 2 weeks. OCCG has been singled out amongst CCGs as successfully attaining the 2ww targets consistently across Thames Valley but there has been a recent increase in patients who have DNAed 2ww appointments made by the surgery, wasting money and slots. If the surgery books the appointment please ensure the patients know.

Please advise patients that they the patient may need to make themselves available over the next 9 weeks, if treatment is required

If patients can't attend then please delay the referral. The cancer pathway runs on the patients' ability to attend.

All referrals should have **a narrative** as well as the salient information on the form. Referrals without any details in the narrative box are likely to be returned for completion.
