





Personality Disorder Training for General Practice



Improve <u>your</u> team's confidence when working with patients with complex emotional issues – for <u>all</u> staff both clinical, managerial, administrative and reception.

Training covers:

- Recognising presenting features of personality disorder, and how it impacts on relationships with professionals
- Responding effectively to patients presenting in crisis
- Improving how your team can support each other
- Understanding what services exist for patients and how they access them

Training is delivered by a multidisciplinary team of:

- GP with special interest in personality disorder
- Specialist trainer with expertise in personality disorder
- Trainers with lived experience of personality disorder

Training is delivered free of charge (funding from Health Education England)

 Funding initially for 20 practices to be trained in the Thames Valley region during Oct 2019 - Sept 2020

Practices will need to:

- Apply (Applications open 17 June—1 July)
- Book 1 x 4 hour training session or 2 x 2hour training sessions
- Identify practice leads
