



Digital Proactive Care Plans


The PCP view has been developed to display information recorded by GPs in their clinical systems to create personalised care plans for their patients. These care plans are intended to assist clinicians providing unplanned care.

Some of this information is also available in the standard medical views. Other information, which is specifically about care planning, can only be found in this view. Where explanation of terms may be required, we have added information in hover boxes in the OCS.

The information is presented in a series of tabs:

- **PCP Summary**: key information e.g. resuscitation status, anticipatory planning for hospitalisation, preferred place of care
- **About the Patient**: e.g. housebound, donor wishes, syringe driver/equipment
- Advance Planning: e.g. power of attorney, advance statements
- Carers and other professionals: carer and health professionals involved
- Recent observations: e.g. heart/respiratory rates, O2, peak flow, blood glucose
- Attached care documents: e.g. resus status, advance statements, care plans

NB: for some Oxfordshire patients (registered at Vision practices), only the **Attached care documents** tab will be available









About the Patient

This view contains pre-existing information about the patient including hearing/vision problems, ECG, donor wishes and details about a living will.



Advance Planning

Contains information on powers of attorney and advance directives, holds documents on advance decisions, and end of life/pallative care registers







Carers and other professionals

This page details the role of other healthcare professionals who are involved in the care of the patient. Including information about the usual GP, and carers, district nurses or social workers who support the patient.
