OCS GP Read Codes: Exclusions

The method by which OCS views primary care data relies on data collection which by national agreement does not show any codes covering STIs, gender reassignment, in vitro fertilisation or terminations of pregnancy. In practice, the main area where this could be clinically relevant is for patients who have HIV. Hepatitis B and C are not displayed either but don't tend to present with opportunistic infections the way HIV does. Please bear in mind these exclusions when viewing data on the OCS. There are no restrictions on other areas; specifically no mental health or drug or alcohol misuse codes are withheld.
