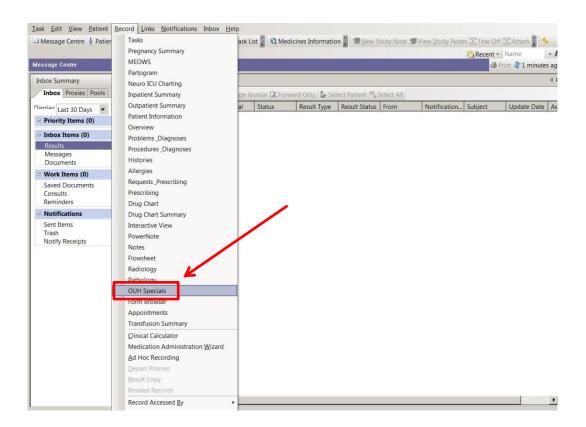
Assumption: you have access to EPR

Logging in to the OCS

1. Log into EPR - and launch the PowerChart application.

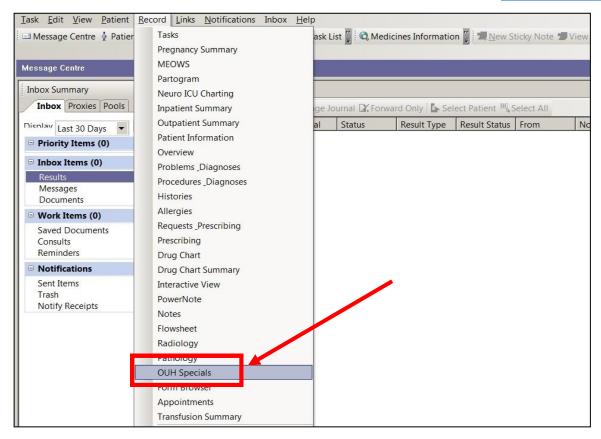


2. You will find a new item available under the Record tab - *OUH Specials* (see the image below) - which will take you to a screen that holds key bits of information

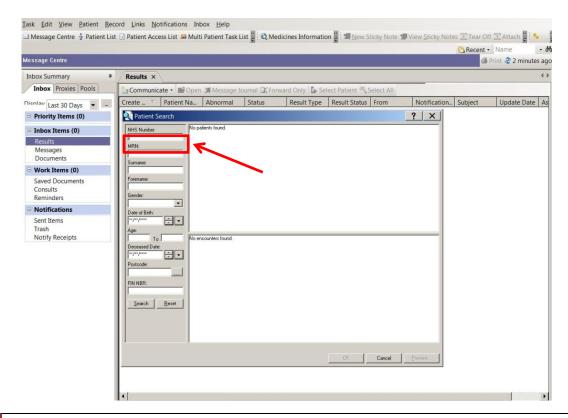








3. You will then be shown the Patient Search screen. You will need the patient's NHS number, or their Name, Gender and Date of Birth in order to search for them.



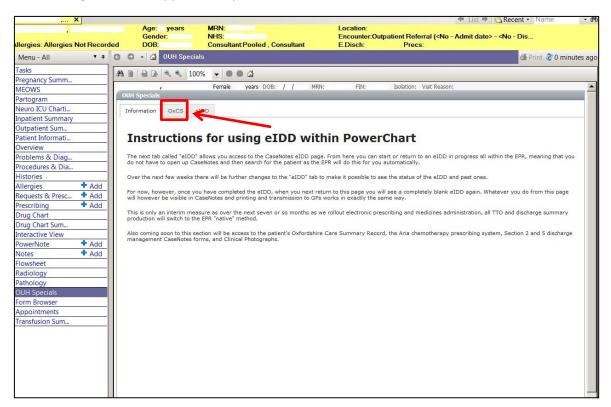




4. The next screen asks you to confirm your relationship with the patient.



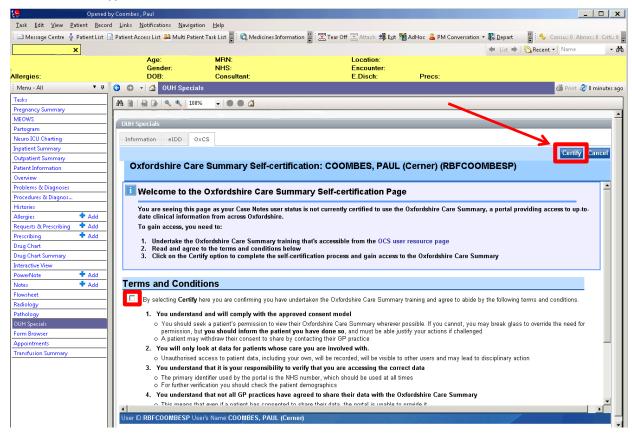
5. The following screen will appear, and you will need to select the OxCS tab.







- 6. First time users of the Oxfordshire Care Summary will have to **self-certify** (NOTE: this includes existing CaseNotes users). If you have already self-certified, go to **step 7**
 - Tick the box to agree that you will abide by the terms and conditions of accessing patient information
 - Select Certify.



7. If in EPR, the patient details will automatically pull through. If there is no information available on a particular patient, you will see one of the following messages:

If the patient has not consented to share, the following message will appear:



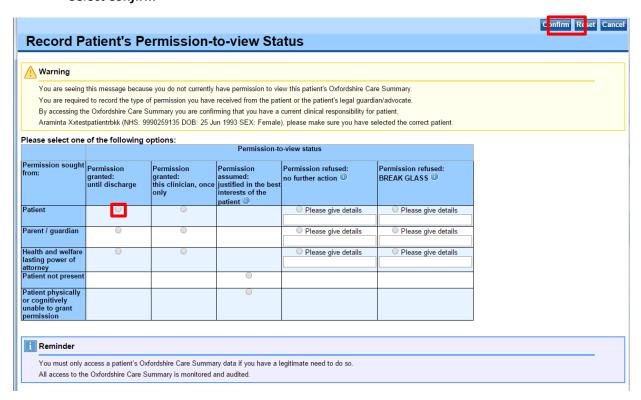
If **no patient record** is held on the Oxfordshire Care Summary, the following message will appear:







- 8. In order to view the patient record, you will:
 - Need to confirm your permission to view status (radio button)
 - Select Confirm



PLEASE NOTE: Permission assumed should be selected when the patient cannot answer because they are not able to confirm permission. Permission refused means the patient has actually denied permission to access their data.

9. The patient record will appear. Select the required information from the **left panel**. Information is presented in tabs by category and source.







Please **NOTE** the following:

- Data is pulled from a variety of sources including OUH and GP users may notice slight variations
- There is a **Combined Medications and Allergy** view (**NOTE**: only data from EMIS Web GP practices will appear on the combined view)
- The record MAY not be the complete record
- The record's accuracy is dependent on the person who input the data.
- Users access is monitored via the Auditing view (screenshots available below)

New patient search

Searching for a new patient can be done in two ways:

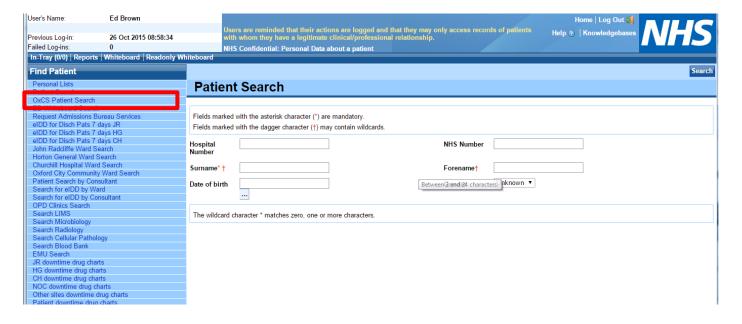
- 1. Via EPR
- 2. Via the OxCS patient search option

Via **EPR**

- 1. Exit the Oxfordshire Care Summary
- 2. Search for the patient in EPR as you would normally
- 3. Go to **step 1**

Via Oxfordshire Care Summary Search option

- Exit your current patient
- 2. Select OxCS Patient Search

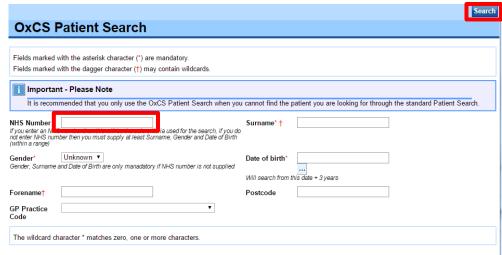






 Type in the patient's NHS number and click on Search

NOTE: Please search using NHS number where possible, otherwise, you will need name, gender and date of birth



If there is a patient on record in the Oxfordshire Care Summary, it will return your options as below (**NOTE**: if there is no record, the system will advise).

4. Click on the patient's name



5. Go to **step 9**

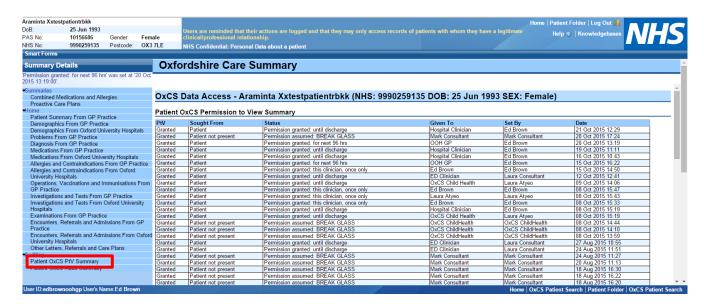




Audit
