

OCCG SERVICE SPECIFICATION (2019/20)

PSA/CLL/MGUS audits

1. Introduction

The LMC has expressed on-going patient safety concerns and a lack of resourcing around the transfer of the monitoring of PSA, MGUS, and CLL from secondary care into primary care. Some practices had voiced that they did not have the capacity to set up a safe call/recall system for this disease monitoring, and current practice IT infrastructure was unsuitable for the significantly increased demand from secondary care.

2. Background

A cross organisation group has met to discuss this issue and see a lasting solution for monitoring via a central database of monitored patients with an automated call and recall system in place. This is currently being worked up.

EMIS (the main clinical system in Oxfordshire) is not set up to provide a safe call and recall system. Instead practices need to run periodic searches to identify which patients need blood testing for PSA/CLL/MGUS. This is a time-consuming process as each patient identified on the periodic search will need to have a clinical look into notes and clinic letters to determine the required frequency of the test and then if they are due a test at that time. If so, the patient will then need to be invited to phlebotomy.

In order to recognise the time taken to undertake a safe call and recall system it has been proposed that a once only fee is paid to each practice while a more automated system is put in place. This is in line with the agreement reached between the CCG, LMC and OUHFT in April 2019 for a six month short term solution.

3. Service Scope

This service will support practices to provide a safe call and recall system whilst a longer term solution is being developed.

4. Service Delivery

Practices should run periodic searches to identify which patients need routine blood testing for PSA/CLL/MGUS. Those patients identified as requiring a blood test should be invited for phlebotomy. Practices are able to claim under the locally commissioned service for 'bloods requested by secondary care' and should act on any abnormal results. *Specification for reference:* [2019-20 spec bloods requested for secondary care](#)

5. Monitoring

In order to reduce any unnecessary burden on practices, no monitoring by the CCG is expected. However the provider should keep records of the audits undertaken.

6. Accountability

The Provider is ultimately accountable to the Commissioner for the delivery of this service.

7. Payment

A once only payment will be made to each practice. Practices that wish to opt out of this service should inform the CCG occg.primarycarecontracting@nhs.net as soon as possible. The payment will be made during October 2019.

It has been agreed that payment will be made based on the number of men >50 on a practice list on 1 April 2019. (As a proxy for the ratio of men with raised PSA).

The maximum budget available is £100,000. This equates to a payment of 77p/patient over 50.

9. Termination

This service relates to a once only payment.
