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SCAM Alert

Using fax machines



A few practices are reporting a new scam which makes use of fax machines. The scammers attempt to scam the practice by requesting a form be completed and faxed back (probably to a premium rate number).

Details of the scam are as follows:

- A fax is sent to the practice asking them to confirm their details by completing a form and faxing it back.
- If no response is received, the scammers phone the practice to confirm receipt of the fax and urge the practice to complete and return it asap (Please do not do this; it is a scam).
- Traditionally, the number provided connects to a premium (slow transfer rate) phone line.

To add a layer of validity, the scammer will claim they work for a company on behalf of the NHS to update the information used by Google Maps to direct patients to the practice (please note, this is false; either the practice has the ability to update details themselves or your support organisation does this for you).

Additionally, the scam requests that the practice sign up for a subscription to make sure their details are always accurate/up-to-date (all for £39 for 24 months).

The scammers will be persistent and will most likely phone back. Please be vigilant and do not be taken in.

National Programme Utilisation



Electronic Prescribing, GP2GP and Patient Online

Practices in Oxfordshire are maintaining a high level of utilisation for the national programmes, including EPS, GP2GP and other patient online services -which is an excellent achievement all round. Notable statistics include:

- **Electronic Prescription Service (EPS) – All scripts.** At least 72% of practices have achieved 56% or better utilisation each month over the past six months.
- **Electronic Referral Service (eRS).** 91% of referrals are going through the eRS system (just below the national average of 92%).
- **GP2GP.** According to the latest figures (July 2018), 99% of Oxon practices have achieved at least 80% integration within three days.

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GP referral pro formas

Keeping system pro formas up-to-date

Zip folders containing full sets of referral pro formas can be found on the [Referral Pro formas](#) page of the OCCG website.

EMIS practices

The zip folder EMIS-Pro-formas, with a date stamp in the format YYYYMMDD, contains all of the EMIS referral pro formas currently in use. It can be saved, and imported in one step from within EMIS Web.

Also found on the Referral Pro formas page, the documents 'How to Cleanse your EMIS Pro forma library' and 'Working with GP Pro formas' give instructions on how to import the single zip folder and remove all old templates which have been replaced.

Vision Practices

Release of these pro formas is not always concurrent with the EMIS forms as they require further processing.

The zip folder INPS-Pro-formas, with a date stamp in the format YYYYMMDD, contains all of the InPS Vision pro

formas currently in use.

Some of these pro formas have been upgraded to include SmartTags, which reduces the need to enter data by hand. They can be identified by a suffix of 's'.

Version 8.5 release – Friday 7 December 2018



EMIS has advised that version 8.5 was released on Friday 7 December.

Details of what was included in the release were originally provided at recent EMIS web user group meetings.

Dates for future user groups will be published in **Wire**, so please do keep an eye out for an announcement in the New Year. These groups are very informative and direct access to an EMIS representative is always available. Key elements included in the release are as follows:

SNOMED

- Finding and adding mapped readcodes using a SNOMED CT concept ID
- Snomed code picker update
- Displaying SNOMED CT concept IDs in the code picker
- Using SNOMED CT concept IDs to create a search

Appointments

- General Practice Workload Tool

- Moving appointments to different slot lengths
