#### **We are still awaiting final guidance on:**

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) required for administering a flu vaccine.

What funding may or may not be attached to 50-64year old cohort.

Additional funding for practices for flu clinics during Covid 19 restrictions.

When national stock will be released for the vaccination of the 50-64year old cohort.
